- » Things that make it safe or unsafe to be active

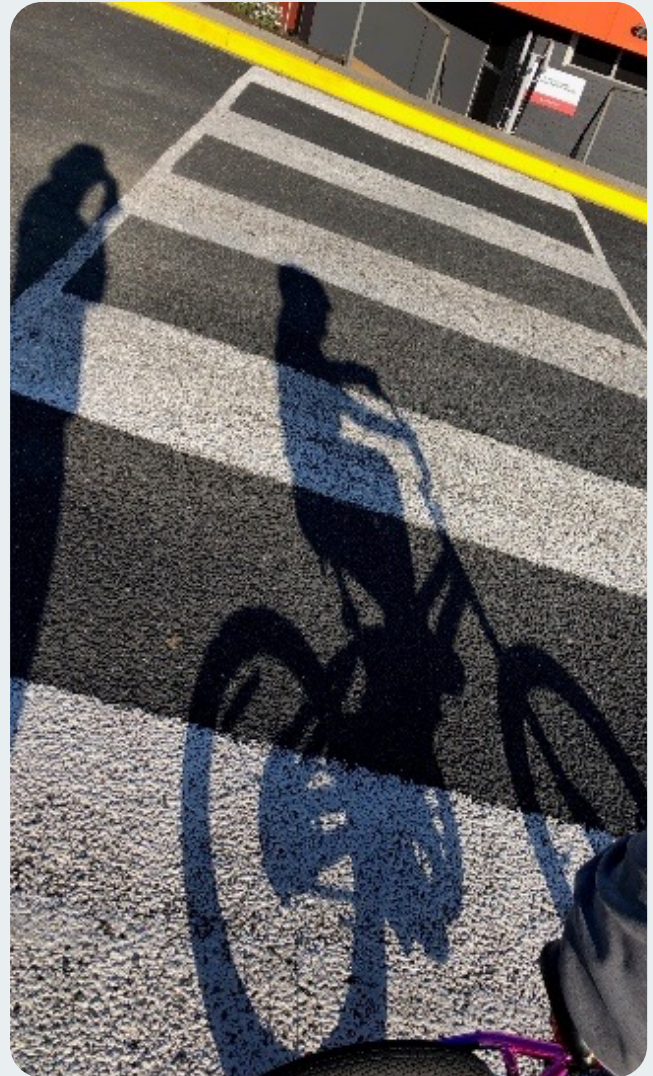


Examples of photos you can take



Remember

- ✓ Please aim to take no more than 5-10 photos
- ✓ You can take photos anytime while completing the segment assessment tool
- ✓ You should take photos of things you want to share with the researchers
- ✓ You can delete any photos you do not like or do not want to show us. Keep the ones you wish to share.
- ✗ Do not take photos of anyone that does not want to have their photo taken
- ✗ Do not take photos of anyone's faces (even if they don't mind being photographed)
- ✗ Do not take photos of your house with street and house number
- ✗ Do not take photos of your family
- ✗ Please DO NOT share any photos that you take for this project on any social media or other online site, including: Facebook, Instagram, Twitter, as well as any personal messaging platforms (Facebook Messenger, WhatsApp, text message, etc.). These photos are for you to share with the research team.
